General Information

- To put on a show demands a lot of dedication from everyone so we must ask that **all** classes including extra classes are attended
- All pupils are invited to take part regardless of age and will perform at least one dance in every genre that they do, however, Jazz & Modern are usually combined. Extra dances will also be incorporated to give a varied programme.
- The youngest children will be in the first half of the show and will be free to go home at approx 8pm. If your child is only in the first half you may take them home during the interval.
- During the show the children are taken care of by **strictly** licenced chaperones only.
- You MUST sign and return the attached disclaimer form to allow your child to take part. This is a requirement of the West Sussex Children in Employment and Entertainment Team.
- For the purposes of the show; class timetables have been altered slightly this term, which will include changes due to exams, bank holidays etc. The new timetable has now been published it was a real headache to fit everything in and these times and days can now NOT be changed my apologies for any inconvenience caused.

Funding the Show

Although a show is great fun to put on, unfortunately it costs a lot of money. It takes about £6000 to hire the theatre, props, lighting and sound etc and then a further £8,000 -£12,000 for costumes. It is for this reason we need to ask you to pay a costume fee contribution of £35 per subject.

How to pay:

You may pay the show fee all at once or a bit each week, whichever you prefer. However all fees must be paid in full by **Saturday 10**th **June 2017**.

Please make cheques payable to 'The Redhurst Schools of Dancing Show Fund'. Please note that this is a separate account to term fees so to help with administration, could you please ensure that you keep the payments separate.
